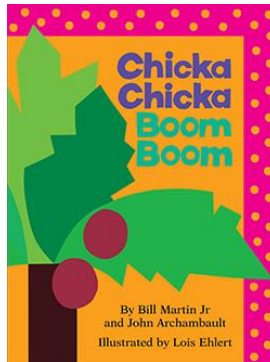

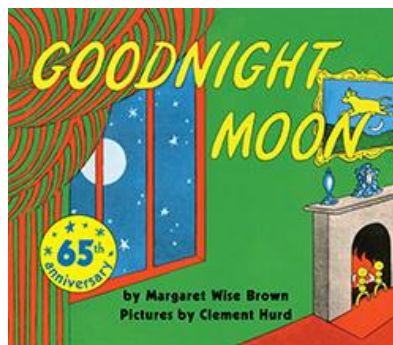

As all the letters of the alphabet climb up the coconut tree, your child's language skills will also be climbing with this classic that teaches letters in a musical way.

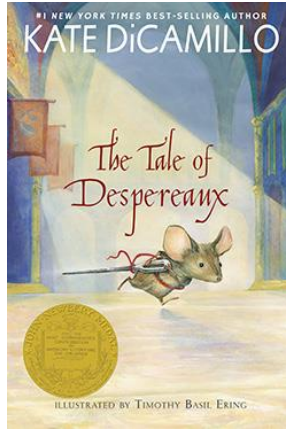


Goodnight Moon

A gentle and soothing book for the end of the day, this is the tale of a little bunny who softly says goodnight to everything in his bedroom.

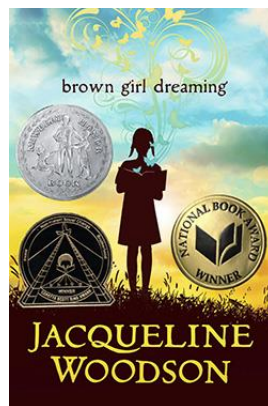
